

Steps to Take for Nomination of Director Election

- Review Director Qualification in <u>Article 3, Section 3.04</u> of Coweta-Fayette EMC Bylaws.
- 2. If you meet the qualifications set forth, consider the following:
 - a. Directors spend an average of six hours per week on CFEMC business.
 - b. Meetings of Directors:
 - i. One regular monthly Board Meeting.
 - ii. Each Director is appointed to one or more committees. Each committee meets based on a schedule determined by committee chair.
 - iii. Director training is required. Directors are encouraged to complete the Credential Cooperative Director Certification
 - (D) within three years of being elected. The cost of the training and expenses are paid by the cooperative. Additional director trainings are available and encouraged.
 - iv. Directors may also attend State and National meetings to learn and stay current on the industry topics. These meetings are held annually.

3. Next Steps:

- a. Complete the petition process and make sure it is submitted by the deadline.
- b. Complete the candidate bio sheet and make sure it is submitted by the deadline.

4. Important Dates:

- a. August 30, 2024 Petition Submission Deadline and Credential and Election Committee Meeting.
- b. September 16-October 14, 2024 Election is open
- c. October 15, 2024 Annual Meeting Day
