



Steps to Take for Nomination of Director Election

1. Review Director Qualification in Article 3, Section 3.04 of Coweta-Fayette EMC Bylaws.
2. If you meet the qualifications set forth, consider the following:
 - a. Directors spend an average of six hours per week on CFEMC business.
 - b. Meetings of Directors:
 - i. One regular monthly Board Meeting.
 - ii. Each Director is appointed to one or more committees. Each committee meets based on a schedule determined by committee chair.
 - iii. Director training is required. Directors are encouraged to complete the Credential Cooperative Director Certification (CCD) within three years of being elected. The cost of the training and expenses are paid by the cooperative. Additional director trainings are available and encouraged.
 - iv. Directors may also attend State and National meetings to learn and stay current on the industry topics. These meetings are held annually.
3. Next Steps:
 - a. Complete the petition process and make sure it is submitted by the deadline.
 - b. Complete the candidate bio sheet and make sure it is submitted by the deadline.
4. Important Dates:
 - a. August 21, 2026 – Petition Submission Deadline
 - b. September 28 - October 6, 2026 – Election is open
 - c. October 6, 2026 – Annual Meeting Day
